

Guidelines for developing Arts Award resources

At Trinity College London, we're keen to support children and young people to achieve Arts Award at any level in any way we can. If you're looking for resources to support your evidencing of Arts Award, our young people's guidance booklets and arts logs are available to purchase from artsaward.org.uk/shop. Also available are a range of free resources to support you with evidence collection from artsaward.org.uk/evidence.

We recognise that, for some organisations, developing bespoke resources or arts logs might be useful to support a particular project or the needs of the young people you are working with. If you are planning to develop your own in-house resources, please ensure that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- Materials must be created by an Arts Award adviser who is trained at the level for which the materials are being produced
- The content of resources must clearly reflect the correct parts/units associated with that level and must clearly articulate what is required in terms of evidence and the assessment criteria as outlined in the most recent version of the Arts Award adviser toolkit
- If you would like to use an Arts Award logo, you may use the **Arts Award centre logo** but not the standard Trinity College London, Arts Award or Arts Council England logos. The centre logo and brand guidelines can be downloaded from artsaward.org.uk/logo
- The content from Trinity College London's Arts Award arts logs may only be used with Trinity's permission
- Centres can only distribute arts logs and resources to young people in their own centre or cluster of centres
- Logbooks or guidance booklets must not be sold without prior permission from Trinity College London
- Trinity College London cannot be held responsible if candidates below pass at moderation as a result of incorrect guidance found in the logbooks or other materials designed by centres or purchased from the shop.

Don't forget to always use your toolkit alongside any arts log or templates to ensure evidence requirements and assessment criteria are fully met.
