Communicate

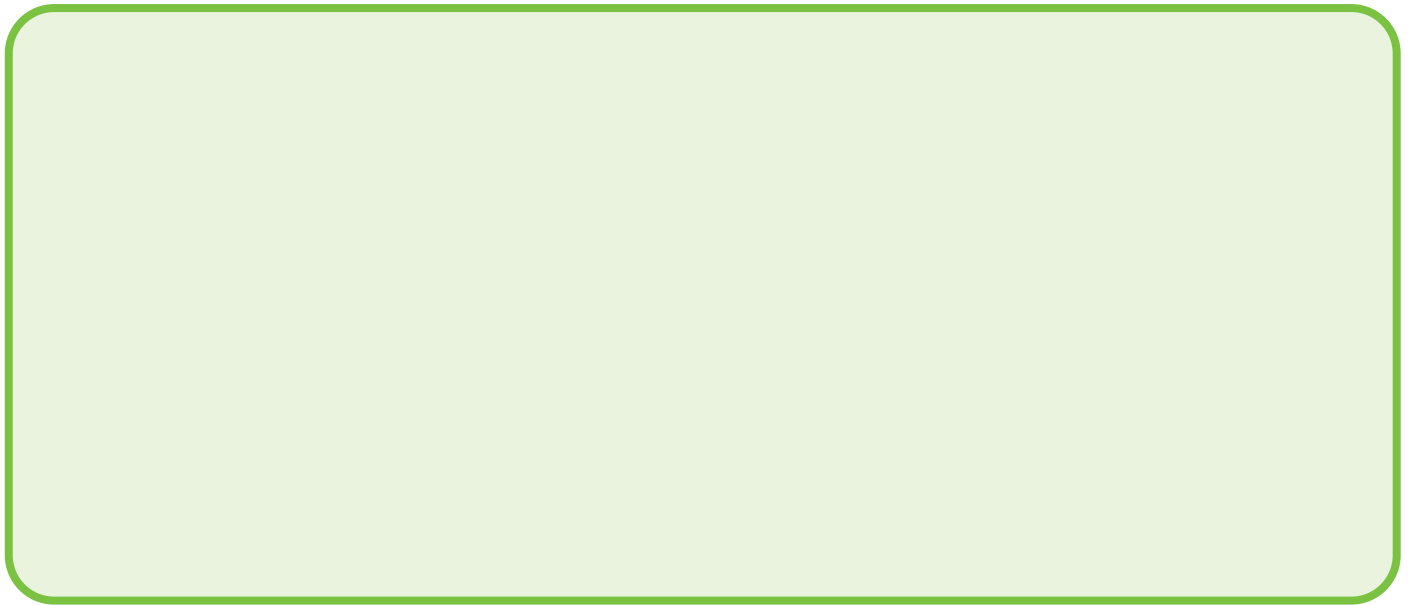
The purpose of this worksheet is to help you form an opinion on an arts issue and share it with others.

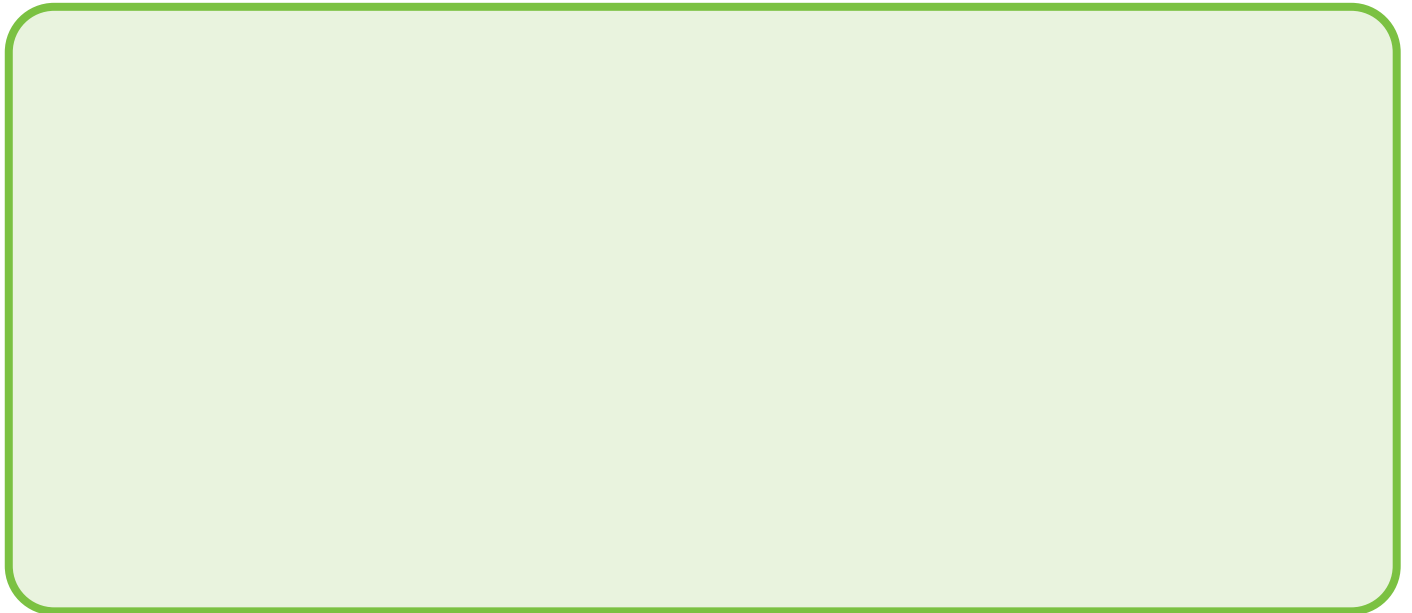
What arts issue did you choose and why?

What was your opinion on the issue before starting your research?

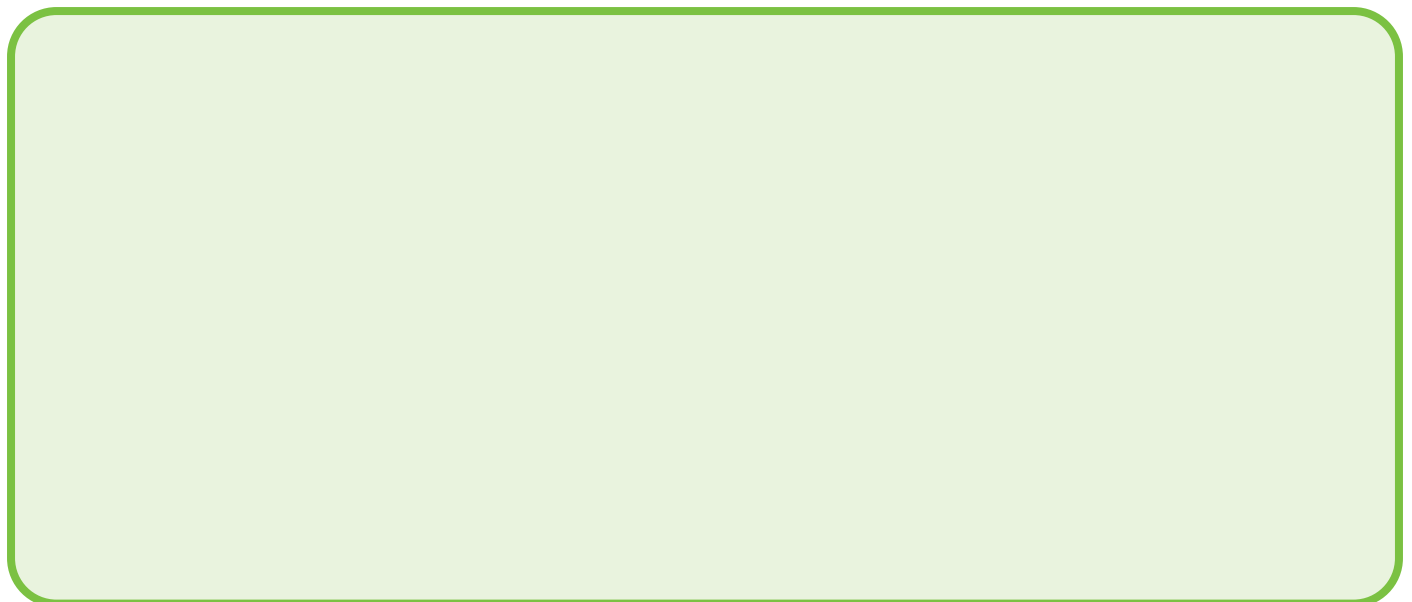
How did you research your chosen issue?



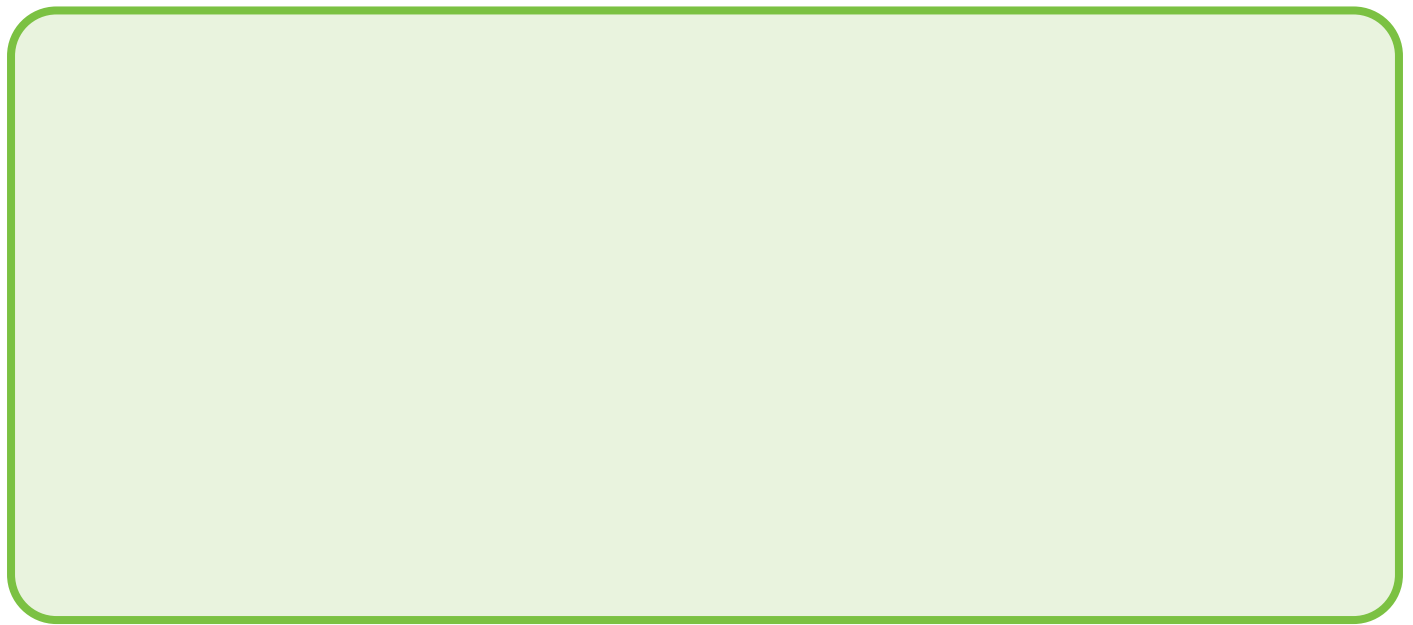
What evidence is there to support your view? Do other people share your opinions?



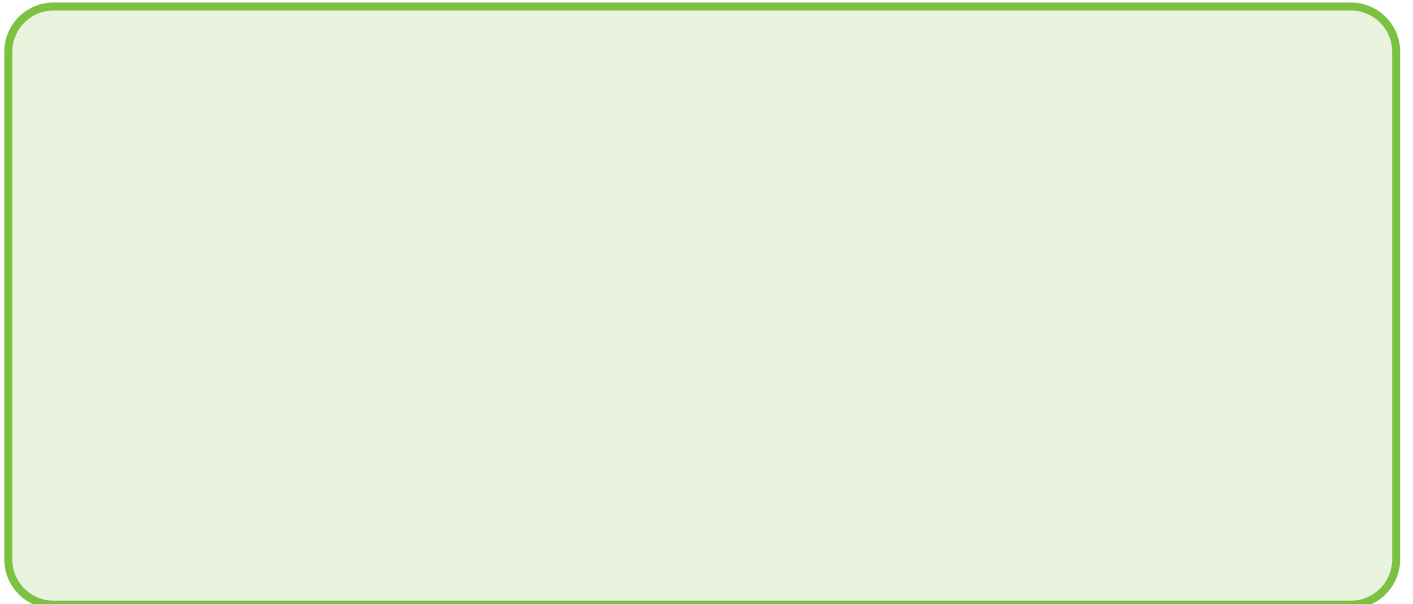
How might someone argue against your opinion? What evidence could they use?



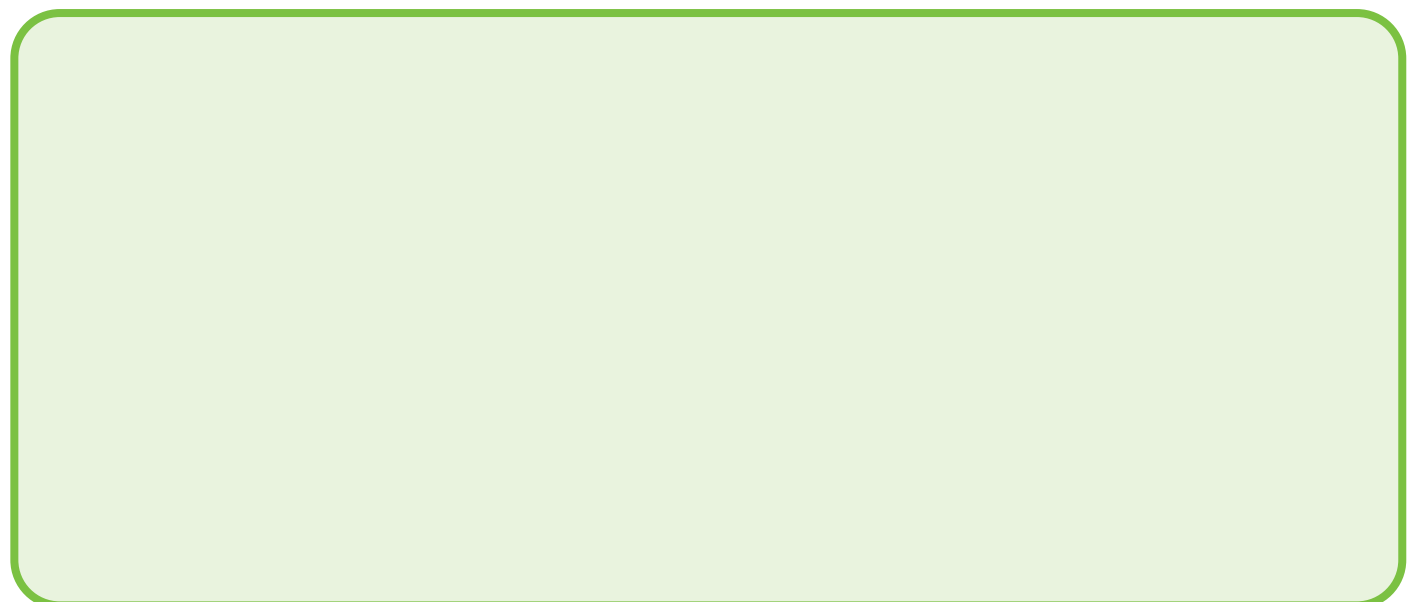
How did your research and the opinion of others influence your views on the issue?
